
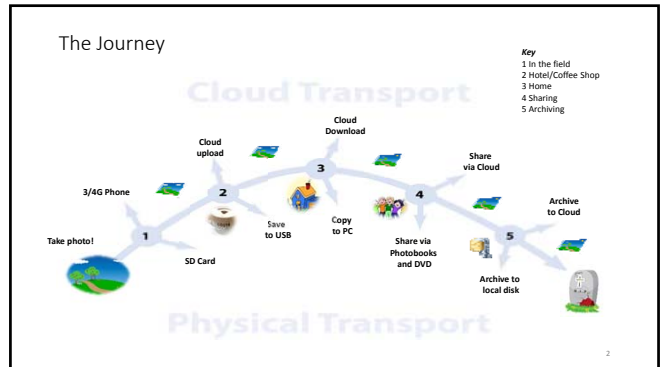

1. In the field – Cloud




- Camera with built in WiFi or Eye-Fi card
- Tablet to View/Edit
- Phone/Tablet with 3G/4G
- Availability and Cost of 3G/4G

- WiFi service availability
- Cost and speed of service
- 3G/4G availability
- MiFi/Dongle availability and cost

3. At home




- Transfer originals to PC hard drive
- Use organiser software or manual file/folder system
- Edit and save new versions, possibly retaining originals
- Set home backup system going – second disk, USB drive, NAS etc.
- Save edited photos to backup Cloud service



4. Sharing




- Set up different Albums for target audiences
- Copy Albums to DVD and despatch
- Send Albums to Photo Book service

4. Sharing



- Set up different Albums for target audiences
- Share selectively from vanilla Cloud service
- Post more widely to social and photo sharing sites

5. Archiving

- Ensure copies of originals and edits are saved to separate disk
- Take physical copies off-site
- Put DVDs in fireproof safe
- Re-copy regularly onto supported media or formats
- Consider archival permanent hard copies for critical images
- Ensure Cloud based archiving service is aware of the new material
- Check Cloud archive regularly (bi-monthly)
