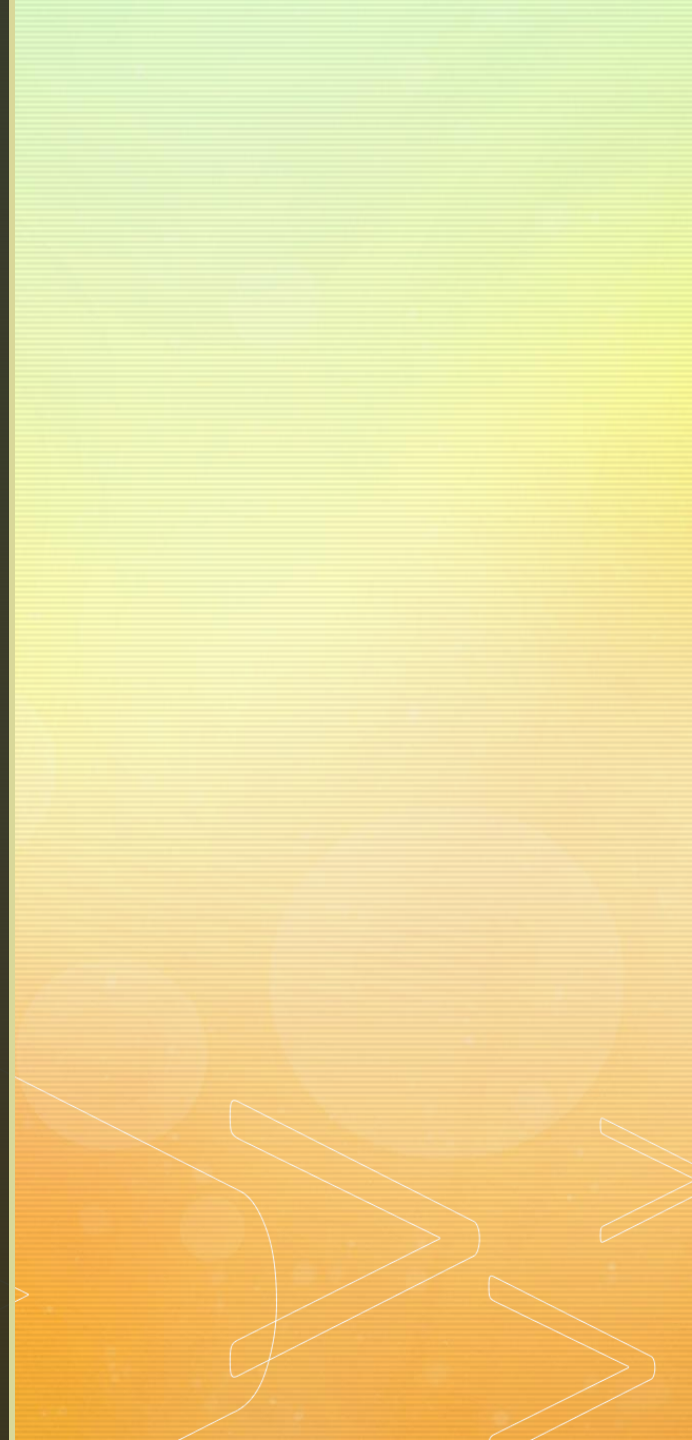

- Screenshots, from Snipping Tool or within PowerPoint

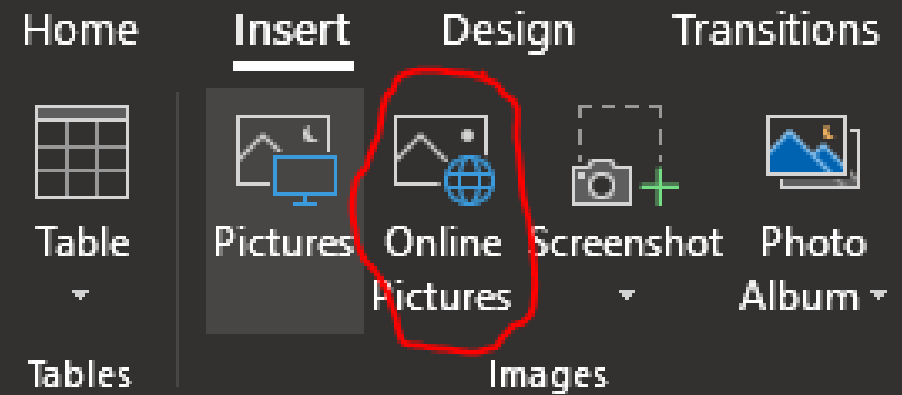
# Most images can be Saved or Copied

Insert into PowerPoint from Web may help clarify Copyright





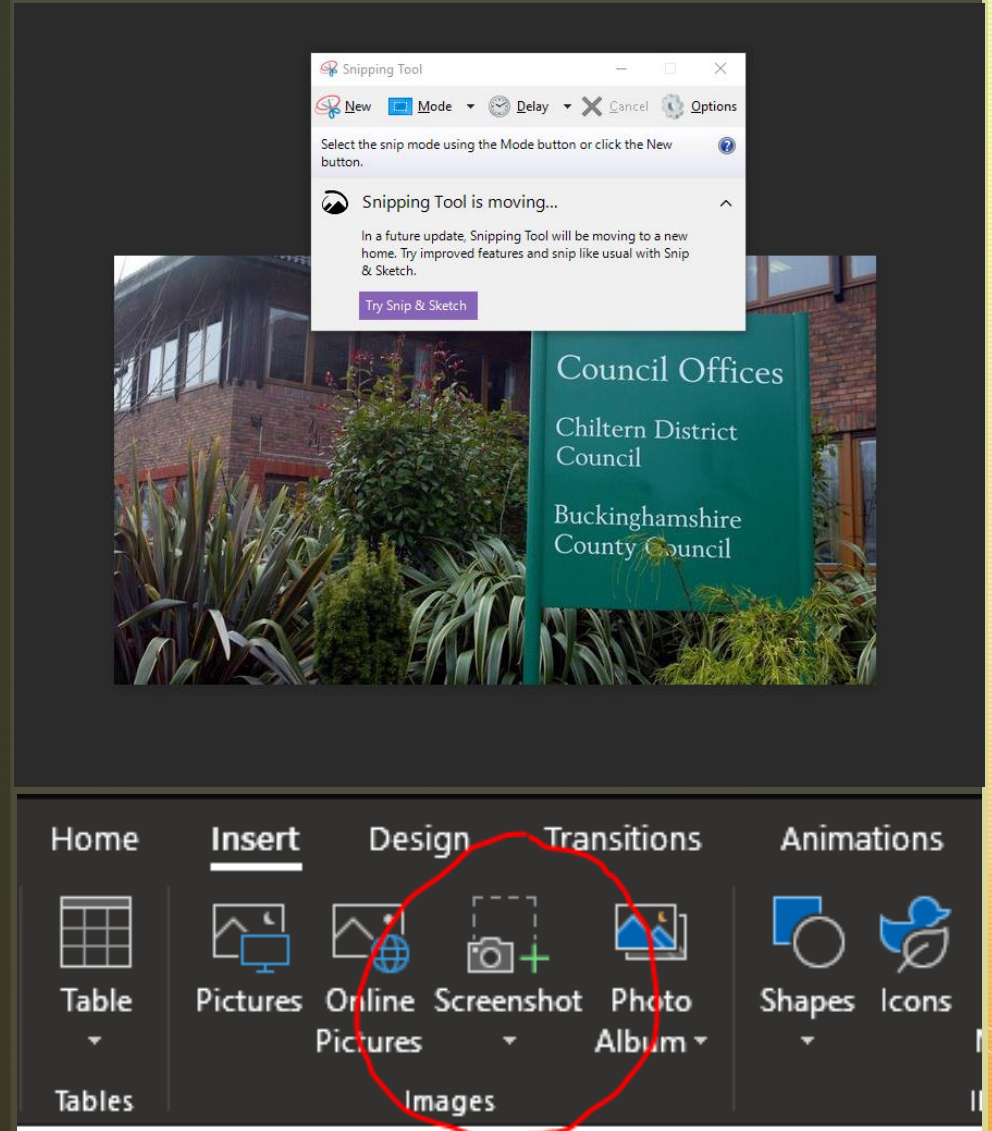

- Image Quality?

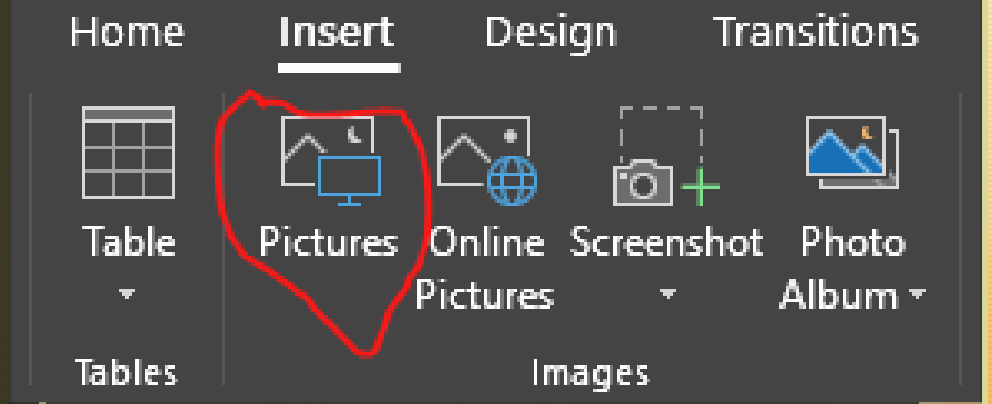
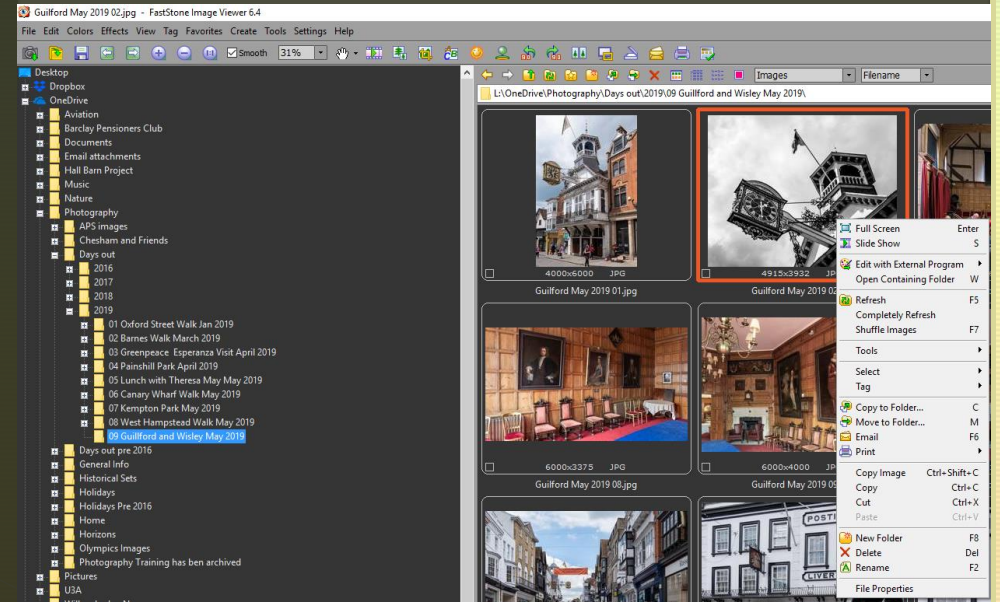
