Excursions and Outings – Terms and Conditions

- 1. In order for Cu3a to be protected by the u3a insurance, only members of a UK u3a can be allowed on outings or excursions. Anyone who is not a member of Cu3a should provide proof of their u3a membership at the point of booking.
- 2. In general, Cu3a outings and excursions are not suitable for persons with limited mobility. For reasons of safety Cu3a cannot offer assistance.
- 3. As with all Cu3a activities, members participate at their own risk. Every effort will be made to explain to potential participants what the excursion entails so that they can evaluate their suitability for it.
- 4. A participant may only bring another person with them for assistance if that person is a member of a UK u3a and a place for them has been paid for in advance.
- 5. If a venue offers free entry to an accompanying assistant, the cost for the assistant will be reduced accordingly provided any requisite paperwork is presented on the day. Transport costs will still apply.
- 6. Participants should be capable of keeping up with the group, and of finding their own way to a meeting point or back to the coach.
- 7. In towns and cities, coaches have limited pick-up time (usually 10 or 15 minutes). Anyone who has not returned to the coach by the appointed time will be left to find their own way home, at their own expense.
- 8. If a potential participant cancels with sufficient notice the venue may reduce its charge, in which case a refund will be made in respect of the venue but not of the transport. If the venue does not reduce its charge, no refund will be made.
- 9. The offer to prospective members of one or two 'taster' sessions, or for members to bring an assistant or an assistance dog to meetings when appropriate and agreed, does **not** extend to outings or excursions.
